



## New Hall Kitchens

New Hall is a modern Cambridge College for women and was built in the early 1960's. The form of the building and innovative construction techniques were formally recognised with its Grade II listing – one of the first 20<sup>th</sup> Century educational buildings to achieve this status.

The College experienced several problems with degenerating concrete, leaking roof and poor space and water heating.

The kitchens in particular were designed to serve a fraction of the current student numbers.

Roger Parker Associates were appointed as part of a team with RH Partnership Architects to replan and refurbish the existing kitchens to suit current standards and legislation.

The work, together with the refurbishment of the adjacent dining room, including the forming of a new servery at first floor level was completed in 2003.

The project was recognised by the RIBA East 'Spirit of Ingenuity' Heritage Award – Conservation in 2003.
