

Perse School Kitchen, Dining and Assembly Hall



The project involved demolition of the existing single storey to allow the new build of a ground floor dining room and comprehensive kitchen and first floor assembly hall complete with control room and working stage.

The new build integrated with the existing building and involved new administration offices and meeting rooms.

The mechanical services included a new plant room serving heat recovery ventilation to the assembly hall and dining room, dedicated kitchen ventilation, heating and domestic services.

Electrically the project involved upgrading the electrical supply to the area and innovative lighting of the spaces to provide visual impact.

Project cost £3.75m completed in January 2008
