RPA were appointed by Architects DEGW to design services for a £200 000 laboratory fit-out contract. Work was to be completed in an eight week contract period so extensive design detailing was required prior to start on site.

Modifications to the existing variable volume air conditioning and controls were carried out to accommodate new fume cupboards. Other mechanical services works included installation of new medical gases, domestic and de-ionised water, heating and drainage systems. Electrical services included general power and lighting and structured cabling for voice and data communications.

All systems were co-ordinated on AutoCAD drawings. To maintain the clients strict cost control the engineering services were fully measured for bills of quantities and RPA worked closely with the client's Quantity Surveyor to ensure cost targets were met at the design stage. The project was handed over on programme in September 1996.
