



Stained Glass Museum, Ely Cathedral

The Stained Glass Museum is a unique museum dedicated to the rescue and display of stained glass. It displays a hundred of the finest pieces and explains the inspiration and faith which led to their creation.

Roger Parker Associates were appointed as consultant and lighting designers in December 1998 to work closely with the Museum and Architects Bower, Langlands and Batchelor to achieve these aims with the museum opening in April 2000.

The solution utilises a variety of lighting techniques from very simple back-lighting of stained glass exhibits with fluorescent lamps to a more innovative use of cold-cathode and fibre optic lighting in the entrance and museum shop.
