



## Lullingstone Roman Villa

Lullingstone is one of only half a dozen excavated Roman villas in the country displayed under cover. Roger Parker Associates were appointed as part of a team undertaking a complete revision of the displays. A new interpretation strategy is enacted to bring Lullingstone's rich collection of excavated objects out of storage and display them on site.

The new audio-visual and lighting displays also bring to life the villa remains in the visitors' imagination.

Roger Parker Associates' design of the mechanical and electrical installations, and in particular the lighting, were the lynch-pin between the audio-visual, interpretation teams and the larger project aimed at revitalising the site which included a complete re-cladding of the cover building and creation of an education room within the existing structure.

The project started on site in late 2007 and completed in Summer 2008.
