



St John's College

St John's College was founded in 1511 by Lady Margaret Beaufort, the mother of King Henry VII and is the second largest of the constituent colleges of the University of Cambridge.

Roger Parker Associates have been involved with work at the College since 1992 when they designed a substantial upgrade to their existing kitchens in the Grade I listed First Court.

The relationship is still ongoing with current projects including the complete refurbishment and re-ordering of the 20th Century Maufe Building and Grade II* listed Merton Hall sited adjacent to the circa 1200AD School of Pythagoras.

RPA are also about to embark on the re-servicing of the 1966 Powell Moya Cripps Building which has recently been upgraded to Grade II*
