

# Ranger's House

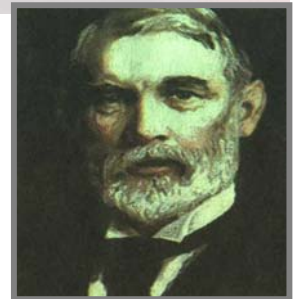

Roger Parker Associates were appointed by English Heritage as mechanical and electrical services consultants for the adaptation of Ranger's House, Blackheath, London, working with the Architects Feilden and Mawson.

Ranger's House is Grade 1 listed and was built between 1700 and 1720 and has been adapted to house the Wernher Collection, a magnificent collection of 650 works of art, including rare Old Master paintings and the largest private holding of Renaissance jewellery in Britain.

The budget for the total project was £1.4m and included the requirement for appropriate lighting and environmental control, and fire and security systems to reflect the importance of the collection, as well as improvements to the existing office and visitor areas.

The project was completed in December 2001.
